<p>Quickly say each of the sounds on the Sounds Chart; change the order each time.</p>	<p>Practise writing your numbers using the number rhymes to help you</p>	<p>Listen to the season song- https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8Zjpl6fgYSY Discuss what happens in each season and changes that take place.</p>
<p>Can you dress yourself? Can you turn your sleeves the right way? Can you do up your own zip?</p>	<p>Can you write the numbers in order to 20?</p>	<p>Think about the season winter, discuss what happens in winter.</p>
<p>Share your reading book with a grown-up.</p>	<p>Using the number line sheet can you fill in the missing numbers?</p>	<p>Can you draw or make a winter themed picture?</p>
<p>Keep a diary of what you have done each day. Can you draw pictures and write some sounds or words?</p>	<p>Can you collect up to 20 objects from around your house and count them? Make sure you count them accurately, one at a time.</p>	<p>Using the summer and winter sorting sheet, cut out the different items and sort them between winter and summer.</p>
<p>Practice counting from 1 to 20.</p>	<p>Collect a handful of objects and place them into two piles. Can you add them together? How many have you got? Can you separate them another way? Can you record your calculation? Repeat with a different amount.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Online</p>
<p>Look for numbers around your house – can you find all of the numbers up to 20? Can you put them in order</p>	<p>Collect 10 objects and separate them into two piles. How many do you have in each pile? Can you find another way of making 10? Record your findings- you can draw the amounts or write a number sentence e.g. '5+5=10'.</p>	
<p>Sing some of your favourite nursery rhymes and songs.</p>	<p>Watch Numberblocks- https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Gt88JrSZIPA&t=212s Can you recognise all of the numbers? Which numbers make 10?</p>	<p>Play Phonics Pop!</p>
