<p><u>Monday English</u> STARS and GEMS - This week we are going to follow instructions to learn about the life cycle of hens. Today look at the PowerPoint in Resources. STARS - tell an adult something you have found out about hens. GEMS - Write down 3 facts that you have found out about hens. Challenge: Write a question about something you would like to find out about.</p>	<p><u>Tuesday English</u> Today you need the Hen Life Cycle in the Resources section. Make sure you select Gems or Stars as they are different. STARS Look at the 4 pictures. Which one comes first? Order them. Decide whether you want to stick them on the hen or in the life-cycle circle. GEMS Using the 2 resource sheets, cut out the pictures and description showing the stages in hen's life cycle and order them. Stick them on the sheet.</p>	<p><u>Wednesday English</u> STARS Use the sheet Life Cycle of a Chicken. Look carefully at the photographs showing the stages of a hen's life cycle. Match the labels to the photos. GEMS You are going to write about the life cycle of a hen. Use the information that you have been given from the PowerPoint and the sheet you completed yesterday. Draft your sentences. Write at least one sentence for each stage.</p>	<p><u>Thursday English</u> STARS - Draw or paint the 4 different stages of the hen's life cycle. Describe what is happening at each stage to an adult. GEMS - Finish writing your instructions. Edit your work by checking the following: Capital letters and full stops, does your writing make sense? Use Fred Talk to sound out words. Copy out your work neatly onto the Hen Border paper.</p>
<p><u>Monday Maths</u> STARS Google Topmarks Shape Patterns. Play this game. You need to predict what the next colour in the pattern is going to be. GEMS Log onto Purple Mash. Type Addition and subtraction 0-20 in the search box. Have a go at solving these questions. Use Dienes or a number line to help you. Challenge: Make up 6 addition or subtraction number sentences for a friend to solve. Mark their work when they have finished. Did they get them all correct?</p>	<p><u>Tuesday Maths</u> STARS Think about the patterns you made yesterday in the Shape Patterns game. Today you are going to make your own repeating pattern - use beads / Lego. GEMS Play Adding 10 Jungle Race (in Resources) - tell an adult what you notice when you add 10 to a number. Challenge: Google Topmarks Robot Addition Use your mental maths skills to see how quickly can you add the numbers together?</p>	<p><u>Wednesday Maths</u> Stars Find 3 objects. Feel how heavy each object is. Order the objects lightest to heaviest. Draw a picture and label it with an adult's help, lightest and heaviest. Gems Find an object that weighs about 1kg - e.g. a bag of sugar. Now find 3 objects that you think weigh less than 1 kg and 3 that you think weigh more. Do this by feeling the weight of the objects in your hands. Make a list of the objects ordering them from lightest to heaviest.</p>	<p><u>Thursday Maths</u> STARS Think about 3 people in your family. Who is the tallest? Who is the shortest? Draw a picture and label it with an adult's help, tallest and shortest. GEMS Think of 5 people in your family / neighbours. Order them according to their height. Make a chart showing each person in order. Label them taller than 1 metre. Shorter than 1 metre.</p>
