<p><u>Monday English</u> Google 'Mr Tumble sign and sing Hickory Dickory Dock'. Join in and learn the signs. Try hard to make the right hand shapes and sing along at the same time, if you can! GEMS - Write out the first two lines of this Nursery Rhyme. Fred Talk the words to help you spell.</p>	<p><u>Tuesday English</u> Answer these questions about Hickory Dickory Dock: Where did the mouse run? Why do you think the mouse ran up the clock? What time was it when the mouse ran down? What could happen next?</p>	<p><u>Wednesday English</u> STARS - learn Hickory Dickory Dock. Practise it and perform it to your family. GEMS - Write out the rest of Hickory Dickory Dock. Fred Talk the words to help you spell. Then practise it and perform it to your family.</p>	<p><u>Thursday English</u> STARS - Draw a picture showing what happens in Hickory Dickory Dock. Tell an adult about your picture. GEMS - Here are the sounds that we have been learning. Say them out loud. m a s d t i n p g o c k u b f e l h s h r k v y w t h z c h q u x n g Now, ask an adult to read them to you. Can you write the letter(s) that match the sound?</p>
<p><u>Monday Maths</u> With a grown up helping, ask if you can look at any coins they have. Use the coin sheet provided to match the coins you have at home to the pictures. Look under Red Room resources - Monday Maths. Describe a coin and see if someone can guess which coin you are describing? These words may help: round, silver, copper, gold, lots of sides.</p>	<p><u>Tuesday Maths</u> STARS Share a packet of crisps or sweets with someone. Can you share them equally? How many did you each have? GEMS Complete the coin recognition sheet. Look under Red Room Resources - Tuesday Maths Gems.</p>	<p><u>Wednesday Maths</u> STARS Pretend you work in a café or restaurant. Use the sheet provided to make up a menu with prices. Look for the sheet under Red Room Resources - Wednesday Maths Stars. GEMS Order the coins by value. You will need scissors and glue. Look for the sheet under Red Room Resources - Wednesday Maths Gems.</p>	<p><u>Thursday Maths</u> STARS With an adult's help, see if you can help prepare a meal for your family. Count the items on the plate. On the plate template provided, draw a picture of what you served up! Choose your favourite colour plate. Look for the sheet under Red Room Resources - Thursday Maths Stars. GEMS Start learning how to add up coins. You are going to pretend to buy some ice creams! Look for the sheet under Red Room Resources - Thursday Maths Gems.</p>
<p><u>Friday English</u> STARS - Donkey, dragon, drip, doll, dog, dig all begin with the sound 'd'. Can you say 3 more words that begin with a d? GEMS - As Stars, then write a list of 6 more words that begin with the same sound. Challenge - can you write a 3 sentences using some of the 'd' words. E.g. The dragon is big and red. My doll has a hat.</p>	<p><u>Friday Maths</u> Stars and Gems Make or draw a repeating pattern. You could use building bricks, or draw around objects.
