Close your eyes while a family member removes one card.</p> <p>Can you work out which sound is missing?</p> <p>Can you say all of the sounds?</p>	<p>Go on a mini beast hunt.</p> <p>Can you write a list of all of the different mini beasts that you found?</p> <p>Remember to use your sounds and that the words do not need to necessarily be spelt correctly. For example: lade (lady).</p>	<p>Find different items in your home that would make a good instrument such as pots/pans etc.</p> <p>Can you use them to create music?</p>
