(see 2dos)</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Complete the pirate addition and subtraction within 10 and within 20 activities on the handouts.  You can use the part, part, whole mat and objects to help you (see handout)</p>	<p><u>Maths - Challenge</u> Have a go at the pirate addition and subtraction code breaker activities. Then colour the treasure in the correct colour. (see handout).</p>
<p><u>Science</u> With an adult have a go at some of the fun pirate experiments. (see handout).</p>	<p><u>Purple Mash - Science</u> Guess which material is being described.
