<p><u>Monday English</u> Tune into our school YouTube channel and listen to the story Chicken Clicking. STARS - Tell an adult which is your favourite part of the story and why. GEMS - Tell an adult what you think we can learn about online safety from this story. Retell the story in your own words.</p>	<p><u>Tuesday English</u> STARS Draw a picture of your favourite part of the story. Talk about what the chick did. GEMS Write a list of all the things that the chick ordered online. Think about what happened first, next, after that, then and finally.</p>	<p><u>Wednesday English</u> STARS - Was the chick being a good chick when she order all those things online? Tell an adult what you think. Trace over these ch words chick chip chop chicken. Now say them. GEMS - Write a list of all the things that the chick did that were not safe.</p>	<p><u>Thursday English</u> STARS - Draw a picture of the fox and tell an adult what you he might be thinking. Write your ideas in a thought bubble. GEMS - Think about what could happen after the story has ended. How do you think Chick was feeling when she saw the fox? Write what you think happened next!</p>
<p><u>Monday Maths</u> This week we are learning about doubles. Look at the Ladybird Doubles PowerPoint in Red Room Resources. STARS Today you are going to paint a ladybird with 2 spots on either side. Record this as an addition sentence. Work out how many altogether and write in the answer. GEMS Write out the doubles that you saw on the PowerPoint like this: 1+1=2 2+2=4 3+3=6. Tell an adult what you have found out today.</p>	<p><u>Tuesday Maths</u> Use the Domino sheet in Resources. STARS Have a game of dominoes. Look out for the dominoes with the same number of spots on each side. These are called the doubles. GEMS Do the same as the Stars. Play this Quick-fire Doubles games with an adult: See how quickly and accurately you can double all these numbers: 6 3 10 2 7 4 5 2 8 1 9. Ask the adult to read out the number and you double it really quickly!</p>	<p><u>Wednesday Maths</u> Play the Double Decker School Bus Ride game in Resources. Stars and Gems - you have your own games to print out and play. Gems - how would you teach someone younger than you about doubles? Have a think and tell an adult. Write down some of your ideas.</p>	<p><u>Thursday Maths</u> STARS Complete the activity provided under STARS Thursday Maths. You may find using Numicon helpful. GEMS Work through the doubles activities provided under GEMS Thursday Maths. You will need an adult to help you.</p>
<p><u>Friday English</u> STARS GEMS - Look at the online safety posters in Red Room Resources. Either make up your own poster or copy one of these. Tell an adult what you think are the most important things you can do to keep safe when you're online.</p>	<p><u>Friday Maths</u> STARS Make another ladybird. This time choose a different number of spots and work out what double that number is. GEMS Ask an adult to help you google Hit the Button game. Click on doubles to 10. You have 1 minute to see how many doubles you can find. Challenge: Keep going and see if you can beat your score.
